Plenary #13 was hybrid, with on site attendance at EUROCAE in St. Denis, FR. The meeting was scheduled for two days, 17 January 2023 and 20 January 2023 and detailed in the Meeting #13 calling notice sent via e-mail on 7 December 2022. The virtual meeting was held via WebEx. On 17 January 2023, beginning after the adjournment of the plenary, through 19 January 2023, RTCA and EUROCAE held a workshop for members of sub-group 2 to continue work on resolution of comments from the recently closed Review and Comment (RAC) period.

#### 17 January 2023

#### 1. Welcome, Introductions

Burak Ata opened the meeting and welcomed the attendees. Burak and Russ introduced themselves as the co-chairs of WG-117 and SC-240.

The participants introduced themselves.

Ross Hannan updated the group that EASA has communicated current state of document is not what is expected, but group will continue attempting to both meet the group and the regulator's needs.


#### 6. Status of WG-2 and RAC

No comments.


Burak Ata moved to approve the minutes, Tom Snider seconded.

The group determined that given the extent of incoming changes to resolve the initial RAC that it would be inappropriate to consider at FRAC at this time. The group decided that a RAC 2,

commencing in March is the current plan of record, to be concluded by the next plenary session midyear.

Ross Hannan: SG1 created a plan in October to create a version that was heavily dependent on the text of 178C. That was done and presented to the PMC and TAC. The TAC and PMC have provided mixed feedback and is seeking additional feedback in February. We will share the decision from the TAC and PMC in the April working group and will hopefully have a clear path of what's going on.
