**SC-224 – Meeting No. 104
(February 5, 2026, Meeting)**

1. Welcome and Administrative Remarks:

Mr. Para opened the meeting by reading the reminders for the Anti-Trust Requirement, Export Compliance Policy, Intellectual Property Policy, Membership Policy, and relevant exemptions, as well as RTCA membership requirements. After the membership update, Dr. Wilkinson presented the agenda for today’s meeting with no changes from the previous agenda. He pointed out that the Change in TOR item should have been removed.

2. Approval of Previous Meeting Summary:

The Summary for the Plenary #103 (November 13, 2025) meeting was presented on the screen and briefly reviewed. The summary was accepted, and Dr. Wilkinson will post it on the AerOpus site after obtaining the RTCA Paper Number from Mr. Para.

3. TSA Report:

Dr. Wilkinson presented on the final decision for the TSA to no longer participate. They were officially removed as a co-chair. Dr. Wilkinson noted that it was the end of an era, as TSA participated for the last 20 years. For the first ten years, they were very active, but over the last ten years, their participation started fading.

4. Change in TOR:

As noted earlier, this item should have been removed from this agenda prior to publishing.

5. Version DO-230N Discussion:

Only two section leaders were present.

Mr. Shane presented his updates to Section 8 on **integration** at the last meeting. Per Dr. Wilkinson's recommendation, he added an example of the micro-architecture and added the Input/Output details in the systems matrix and explained in detail what was meant by micro-architecture. He hasn't finished all the edits yet. He indicated he was open to additional comments and stated he would add the file to the shared site after this meeting. He intends to have the draft on the site by the end of February.

He also added trends and a checklist. There were no comments from the group.

Mr. Martin stated that he skimmed everything. Most of his changes were code-centric: changed UL language to the regulatory language, as well as the International Building Code. He added more information on automated exit breach control, added card readers for cleaning, power, and UPS backup on sterile to public lines. He also added verbiage for man-traps, emergency egress for safety, and a section for self-baggage drop-offs, which are starting to pop up in places. Another added section will be on delayed egress.

Dr. Wilkinson requested the draft to be posted on the AerOpus site for others to be able to review. He enquired if there was any progress on replacing the site, since it is not very intuitive. Mr. Para advised that at the moment, everything regarding the AerOpus replacement is status quo.

Mr. Martin also inquired about the possibility of updating the drawings and pictures. Dr. Wilkinson cautioned him about potential copyright issues. Pictures from the Federal Government can be used freely. There is also no issue with Mr. Martin redrawing the pictures himself. Mr. Martin's final comment was regarding the near field communications. He plans to review the section again, but did not have a chance to get to it yet.

6. Action Items:

Dr. Wilkinson provided an **update** on the previous action items:

- Dr. Wilkinson will contact Mr. Martin regarding his section (PACS) – Mr. Martin provided an update to his section
- Dr. Wilkinson will contact Mr. Chris Bidwell with ACI-NA to try to recruit new airport members to assist with the report – Mr. Bidwell did not respond to Dr. Wilkinson's

request. Dr. Wilkinson asked Mr. Para if ACI-NA was still a member. Mr. Para was going to check

- Mr. Para will work with Ms. Morrison to resolve the TSA participation on the Committee - TSA's participation has now been resolved. They no longer participate

New Action Items:

- Dr. Wilkinson will reach out to Ms. Spencer and Mr. Sorensen regarding their absence and to obtain the updated versions from them.
