SC-216 & WG 72 TOR - Meeting minutes

- Rebecca Morrison and Anna Guégan presented the RTCA and EUROCAE plenary meeting mandatory slides including the RTCA and EUROCAE anti-trust, IPR, GDPR, recording, AI use, participation and membership policies. Rebecca included an export compliance policy slide.
- Updates to SC216 TOR sheet was discussed. Summary of discussions and important decisions by the committee are captured below.

Note : Eurocae Task Sheet updates were not discussed in this plenary. The WG72 task sheet is planned to be updated offline in alignment with the TOR updates from this meeting. This TOR update will be finalized in next PMC meeting towards end of Sept. Similarly, the task sheet will be discussed in Eurocae TAC meeting later in Sept as well.

1. RR-FAQ : Date updated from March 2025 to Dec 2025, publish Mar 2026
2. DO-356B : Decision was to move from Change1 to RevB (a full revision). Hence the new schedule for Dec 2028, publish March 2029
3. DO-392A : New schedule for Dec 2026, publish Mar 2027
4. DO-355B : New schedule for Jun 2027, publish Sept 2027 to prevent many FRAC activities in parallel.
5. DO-ISMS : New item. This is a follow on to recently published RR-007 (ISMS) report. Schedule set to Dec 2026 with publish Mar 2027
 - Stefan, Anna and Rebecca discussed the delays in publishing RR-007 (ISMS).
 - Stefan : Discussion with Rasmussen on PART-IS operating maturity at 18 month period. As the current timeline of DO-ISMS is Mar 2027, it would be good to get an extension. If not, prioritize most frequently required items first to meet this date. But then continue as REV-A if necessary
 - Mario : If the 18 month period holds then Mar 2027 date gives industry only 6 months at best.
 - Anna : Can we do a ER-ISMS ver2 instead of DO-ISMS.
 - Alain : Suggests keeping the schedule for ISMS even if aggressive, as they need to target the date for AMC-GM.
 - Mario : EASA wants to aim for DO-ISMS to be AMC. This is not confirmed. Referencing as GM is possible.
 - Nicolas : For Mario's comments - whether we do ER or ED for ISMS, this requires EASA internal discussion. Action for Nicolas.
 - FAA - For AMC and for FAA AC we need consensus standards. Hence DO and ED documents are necessary. ER and RR reports will not work.
6. Nicolas : Inquired about a prior presentation on refutation testing and asked if this would be added to the ToR as well? Suggestion was a dedicated appendix in the DO-356B/ED-203B instead of a standard.

- Siobvan – For the refutation testing as standard, who would be the owner? Suggested bringing this topic in ARC to find an owner and discuss costs/benefits. Not ready to add scope to SC-216 yet..
7. New item - RR Report for common definitions/terms added to this WG scope.
 8. Rebecca : Today’s meeting was meant to update overdue dates. Expressed concerns about adding additional documents while moving existing schedule dates.
 - Alain : Explained that 356 Change1 to 356B was a change of scope and not just delay.
- Siobvan went over the details of the above changes and new documents .
 - Closing Remarks : None.

Actions

1. Nicolas to have an internal meeting within EASA to finalize whether an ER or ED document should be created for next update to ER-040.
2. Siobvan / ARC committee members – Refutation testing as a standard – find owner and discuss cost/benefits. Need this discussion at ARC level.
